




Figure A2. Electoral volatility in six Southeast Asian democracies (1992-2020)


Figure A3. Parliamentary fragmentation in six Southeast Asian democracies (1986-2020)







Figure A5. Party system closure in six Southeast Asian democracies (1986-2020)

Note: Y-axis indicates the score of closure. *Source*: Casal Bértoa and Lee (2021)


Figure A6. Fragmentation (ENPP) and polarization six Southeast Asian democracies (1986-2020)
